I'm sure you'll be inspired by her remarkable — and Mighty — arrangement. I know I was!

"Greetings,

"I am a chiropractor (and homeopath, educator and functional medicine practitioner) in Texas. We have to stock lots of remedies. This is how we store them.



When we run low on a remedy, we put an orange dot on the drawer to remind us to order more.

Some of the units had dividers in the drawers; others didn't. Nevertheless, each drawer perfectly fits 6 remedies.



Labels can be placed on the front of the drawer. The drawers come out and can be moved around for re-organizing or re-alphabetizing convenience. Units can sit on a counter or hang on the wall, which is a great space saver for us.

“Some drawers have single remedies in them, other drawers share remedies or have multiple potencies of the same remedy. Liquid remedies, tinctures or Hyland cell salts can sit on top. For home use, single drawers could be labeled for fevers, headaches, joint pain, sore throat, etc.
